

Three new stations for Metro line 3

From 14th of February, service on Metro line 3 will be interrupted on the section of "Ethniki Amyrna – Douk. Plakentias – Airport" and line 3 will terminate at "Ethniki Amyrna" station.

This interruption is necessary due to the construction of the new station "Aghia Paraskevi", which has not been included in the original design plan of 2003.

This part of the line will operate again after six months, when three new stations ("Nomismatokopio", "Holargos" and "Aghia Paraskevi") will gradually become operational, along this section.

"Nomismatokopio" is considered a principal station since it will be the first station on Mesogeion Avenue servicing passengers coming from Aghia Paraskevi, Mesogeia and the coast of eastern Attica.

A bus transfer station will operate there, as well as an underground car-parking facility for 630 vehicles.

Tickets and Travel cards

Passengers will use the integrated ticket costing €1 and the reduced-price ticket costing €0,50, which are valid for multiple trips on all public transport options in any direction for up to one and a half hours.

The price of monthly unlimited-travel cards are as follows:

- Monthly unlimited-travel card for buses, trolleybuses and the tram €15.
- Reduced monthly unlimited-travel card for buses, trolleybuses and the tram €8.
- For all public transport €35.
- Reduced for all public transport €18.

In addition, the prices for monthly cards exclusively for use on the Athens-Piraeus electric railway or the Metro, are as follows:

- For the Athens-Piraeus Electric Railway only, €25 (reduced €13).
- For the Metro only (as far as Koropi), €30 (reduced €15).

Passengers possessing annual cards of exclusive use of Metro only (value €300) can circulate free of charge in all means of public transport, for as long as the construction of the new stations lasts, even if they are not holders of annual card for all public transport options (value €350).

Passengers who already possess an annual card of exclusive use of Metro only and do not wish to use the above, can return the annual card at OASA head quarters, (25 Metsovou Str., Athens), from Monday to Friday, 08:00 - 14:00, from 10/02 to 31/03/2009 and they will be reimbursed the value of the annual card, reduced by an equivalent amount of money, corresponding to the time in use so far.

ADDITIONAL PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION AT "ETHNIKI AMYNA" STATION DURING THE TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF SERVICE ON METRO LINE 3

From 14th of February, service on Metro line 3 will be interrupted on the section of "Ethniki Amyna – Douk. Plakentias – Airport" and line 3 will terminate at "Ethniki Amyna" for a six month period. To serve passengers, the Athens Urban Transport Organization has planned the following:

Buses (ETHEL)



✓ Operation of 2 new substitution bus lines:

- **Express bus line X5 "Ethniki Amyna - Halandri - Doukissis Plakentias"**, stopping only at metro stations. It will run approximately every 10 minutes at peak hours.
- **Express bus line X6 "Ethniki Amyna - Doukissis Plakentias"**, stopping at stations «Ethniki Amyna», «Doukissis Plakentias» and «Keas» at Al. Panagoulis Street. It will run approximately every 5 minutes at peak hours.

✓ The frequency of **A5 bus line "Akadimia-Aghia Paraskevi-Anthousa"** will be increased. It will run approximately every 8 minutes at peak hours.

✓ **Other bus services remain unaffected.**

Trolleybuses (ILPAP)



✓ Trolleybus line **19 "Mouseio - Halandri"** has been extended to "Halandri" metro station. It runs every 10 minutes at peak hours.

Athens International Airport

Athens International Airport is served by:

- ✓ The bus lines **X94 and X95** from "Ethniki Amyna" metro station.
- ✓ The **suburban railway**, which has been improved from July 2008 and is running more frequently (approximately every 15 minutes).
